Job Descriptions and Skills:

- Provide direct ABA therapy to individuals with Autism or other related disabilities
- Implement interventions within client's Behavior Improvement Plans, as designed by the BCBA/BCaBA.
- Respond appropriately to feedback during supervision sessions
- Complete digital objective session notes within 24 hours of session completion
- Take data during sessions via digital data collection through the CentralReach platform
- Direct all ideas, concerns, and parent reports to the Lead Analyst/BCBA on the case
- Attend monthly staff meetings
- Attend monthly Parent Workshop, Social Hour, and other events, as needed.

Requirements:

- Current RBT credential. If not a current RBT then must meet one of the following requirements:
 - High school diploma with a minimum of 2 years experience providing direct services to individuals with Autism and/or related developmental disabilities, and be willing to acquire the RBT credential prior to start date of employment
- OR
- Associates degree or higher in behavior analysis or a related field, and be willing to acquire the RBT credential prior to start date of employment
- Must have a valid driver's license and reliable transportation
- Possess, or be able to attain, a Medicaid ID number
- CPR/First Aid Certification
- Safety-Care Specialist Certification, preferred
- Bilingual a plus
- Computer literate with reliable internet access
